

2019 Quidditch Australia Rules Amendments

Below is a list of amendments placed on the IQA Rulebook 2016-2018 by Quidditch Australia for the 2017 season within Australia.

- 1.4.2.C.** Players may leave the player area to fetch equipment, such as water, headbands etc. at the discretion of the Head Referee or an Assistant Referee.
- 2.4.1.A.** Wood and/or other materials cleared by the Head Referee during an equipment check before a game are acceptable (for brooms).
- 2.5.2.E.** Mouthguards are not compulsory for QA sanctioned events. Regardless, QA still strongly recommends the use of mouthguards when playing.
- 2.5.4.A.** Player jerseys purchased before the beginning of the 2019 season may still have 3-digit numbers or other designs (pi, X etc.). However, from the start of the 2020 season, these will not be accepted.
- 2.5.5.D.** Glasses may be worn on field.

The above amendments are a temporary set of deviations from the 2018-2020 rulebook for the 2019 quidditch season in Australia, pending further deliberation by the gameplay committee, once it has been formed at the end of January. Further changes, including to the amendments listed above, may or may not be made.
